Promising puppy with masculine head ad good front, well bodied and of correct proportions, moved well but lacked the maturity of 1.

1st - Beresford Stand N' Stare (Mrs T E Topliss)

Class 19. Post Graduate Bitch Entries: 5 Absentees: 2

1st - Calvdale Half A Story Bethersden (Mr G & Mrs S Tolladay)

Smart 2yr old black and white who is 100% female, maturing nicely and all in proportion. Pretty head with kind expression. Sound happy mover. BB&W

2nd - Shersona I Believe in Angels at Beresford (Mrs T E Topliss)

Well-developed bitch of good type, well balanced, moves soundly but needs to slow down. Preferred the femininity of winner.

3rd - Daenerys Moondancer to Cherishym (Mr P & Mrs Y Richardson & Terry-Richardson)

Class 20. Mid Limit Bitch Entries: 4 Absentees: 1

1st - Barecho Cover Girl of Svenjak (Imp Swe) (Miss A L Gardiner)

Presents a mature balanced picture overall, head of correct proportions straight front. Would like more bone and tighter feet.

2nd - Crackerjanne Cassiopeia (Mrs V K Pattison)

Well balanced with all in the right place, well bodied and in excellent coat and condition. Moved well.

3rd - Petranella Perfick Bliss (Mrs M Proctor)

Class 21. Limit Bitch Entries: 3 Absentees: 1

1st - Pinereoch Amethyst of Rosannoch (Mrs E Rose)

Mature well developed bitch of good proportion in excellent coat and condition well proportioned head, good spring of rib, short coupled and sound mover.

2nd - Lymnoares Ode to Memory (Mrs E Hoare)

Not as mature as winner and not ready for a limit class. Has a balanced outline but needs time

Class 22. Open Bitch Entries: 4 Absentees: 2

1st - Sh Ch Melverly Iridescent (Mr R J Smith)

Presents a finished picture, mature, balanced with good topline, well angulated with good bone and feet. Went well both coming and going.

2nd - Meltarose Madeleine at Meonstoke (Mrs K C Taubman)

In a lighter frame than winner, well developed ribs, pleasing head and expression, moved soundly.

Class 23. Champion Bitch Entries: 2 Absentees: 0

1st - Sh Ch Calvdale Flutter JW (Mr & Mrs M Calvert)

Worthy champion who fits the standard well, now fully mature , feminine all through with correct outline and balance, sound mover.

2nd - Sh Ch Meverly Vignette (Mr R J Smith)

Another who fits the standard well, just found her a little heavy today but deserves her title. Was sound on the move.

Class 24. Veteran Bitch Entries: 2 Absentees: 1

1st - Potrail Turns The Swag On for Pinereoch (Ms L & Mrs A H Wilson & Connor)

Not flashy but a sound typical springer that fits the standard well. Balanced outline, well angulated in full coat. Happy sound mover. BVIS
