MPD (1) 1 Elazlan Night Hawk (Darling) B/W, mature, deep in body, short in back with spirit level topline. Typical correct head with gentle expression. Great on the move, correct both ways. PD (2) 1 Dexbenella Livin The Dream (Walker) L/W attractive boy, he is fully mature for a puppy. Balanced head with a wonderful square muzzle. Great bone and feet, so well made in front and excellent rear angulation. Coat completed the picture. He excelled on the move. 2 Chanangel Yorkshire Ale with Bethersden (Tolladay) L/W is not as finished as my winner, but is another great-quality puppy and so much my type. He has a correct head with a dark eye and melting expression. He has a good shoulder and wonderful width behind. He is another great mover who demonstrates good driving action. I am sure these two promising puppies will change places as they progress through their careers. JD (2) 1 Gleadsbury Whataboy at Mujascal (Such) L/W is a beautiful boy I liked very much. The correct amount of bone and substance. Full of quality. Gentle head, loved his expression. Excellent lay of shoulders, wonderful width and second thigh. He is a picture on the stack. Sound and true on the move, he could have driven just a tad more, but it was a quality exhibit nonetheless. Top-notch presentation. 2 Gleadsbury Mad About The Boy (House) L/W brother to winner who is also of lovely quality and just as well made, but not as ready as his littermate. Liked his size and shape, not overdone—wonderful elegant neck leading in well-made front. Less together on the move, but his drive was excellent. A difficult choice to make. YD (1) 1 Teignvalley New Beginnings JW (Hill) B/W adored this boy on his stack. His head is glorious, so balanced, with such a gentle expression. Ample neck. Deep in body short in back with great rear stifle angulation. Typical youngster who needs more width throughout which hopefully will develop with age. He is sound on the move but lacks the driving action required at present. Maturity should help with my comments, PGD (3) 1 Cobhay Dashing Dandelion JW (Williams & Toublic) a L/W boy I have seen and admired before having my hands on him. He ticked so many boxes with only one issue that I knocked him for in another class. He is full of quality with the most beautiful head, dark eyes and melting expression, just so correct. Balanced throughout, deep in body, good angles throughout. He is perfect for muscle tone, with an exceptional second thigh. Moved soundly and true when settled. 2 Peasblossom Brogan at Gaolachcara (Stevenson) L/W promising youngster who still needs to come together. Liked his head and expression. He has Great depth of body and good rear angulation. Not as positive on the move as I would like but sound nonetheless. 3 Hunterheck Fade to Black (Le-Clerc) LD (3) 1 Dexbenella It's Only Me (Walker) B/W what a beautiful typical and correct head. Balanced throughout and not overdone in bone, size or extreme angles. He really is typical and ticks the boxes when assessing him against the standard. Moderate reach of neck leading into a well-made front, he is deep in body and well angled behind. Sound on the move, he could excel further if moved at a faster pace. Worthy CC winner. 2 Beresford On My Way with Acregate (Tracz) L/W another top draw male. He sports a beautiful head and expression, so gentle and melting. He is a truly honest dog, yet again a great example of how the standard should be interpreted. I do think that having a different handler somewhat unsettled and hampered him on the move which was a shame. 3 Eastfalla Sherlockholmes (Warrener) OD (5) 1 Elazlan Billy Kimber (Darling) B/W who I awarded BP in show, is maturing into himself but still is a youngster who is still to fully finish. The most elegant outline, with such a well-chiselled skull and melting eyes. Arched neck leading into well-placed shoulder, spirit level topline which he held on the move where he really excelled and came into his own taking the class. Sadly he decided to play up in the challenge excluding him from higher honours. 2 Cherishym Dofida (Richardson & Terry-Richardson) B/W who truly deserves his title, he has gone through many changes over time as one would expect in the breed. Today I was presented with just what I had hoped for. Spot on for size and substance he sports the neatest of feet. The head having now fully broken is gentle and well chiselled. Darkest of eyes and the most melting expression, lovely to go over, he is so balanced and well-made. Though he would be my class winner and go further, he had other ideas and would not collaborate with his handler, my biggest disappointment of the day 3 Sh Ch Beresford Bolt from The Blue (Topliss) Special Beginners D (3) 1 Eastfalla Sherlockholmes (Warrener) B/W he has a very lovely head, dark eyes and gentle expression. Well made in front, could do with far more

angulation behind and spring through the ribs. Won the class on his movement which was sound and true. 2 Hunterheck Fade to Black (Le-Clerc) B/W checked my notes and read, just my type with glorious head. A very honest and balanced dog he is good to go over, though he would be my winner but he was erratic and not at all together on the move. 3 Pinhays Pie in The Sky (Kibby) Good Citizen Dog Scheme D (3) 1 Sh Ch Beresford Lockdown (Topliss) L/W typical true Springer in type and shape, very much what I expect to see in the breed. Spot on for size, balanced and deep throughout. Sports a beautiful head and melting expression. Great width in rump with such neat hocks. On the move, he was sound in front but slightly favoured his back right. Liked him a lot. RCC 2 Cobhay Dashing Dandelion JW (Williams & Toublic) - see P/G 3 Eastfalla Sherlockholmes (Warrener) MPB (3,1) 1 Elazlan Elle for Leather (Calvert) L/W. OMG, what a precious baby, loved so much about her, at just a puppy she is so balanced throughout. Short deep in body, sweetest of heads. Exceptional in rear. Bone not overdone and neatest of feet. She moved so soundly, a dream puppy. No hesitation in awarding her BP in breed. 2 Peasblossom Emotions with Teignvalley (Hill) B/W so unlucky to meet my winner as this little girl is also hugely promising. Her head is fabulous and already so correct. She is what you would normally expect from a puppy as she is not as balanced and together. Sound but a bit erratic on the move. I can however envisage a promising career. PB (5) 1 Chanangel Yorkshire Honey (Calvert) L/W I predict another star for the future of this baby. So balanced and correct on the stack. Wonderful to see a great textbook example in many areas, she is not overdone in any way, and is moderate throughout. She held her excellent confirmation together on the move presenting a pleasing picture. 2 Annavah Ablaze (Havard) L/W another girl who appealed in profile, a tad longer than winner but as she drops into her body this will make her look shorter. Such a well-chiselled and balanced head. Looser on the move but forgivable due to her age. I liked her very much. 3 Spuffing Bellini (Weyman) JB (2) 1 Forgespring Nobody's Fool at Blissenbea (Proctor) B/W A very pretty ultra feminine girl who is just out of puppy and therefore is still very much a baby and raw. Everything is there for the future and I am sure she will mature beautifully. Moved OK but a little close behind today. 2 Pinhays Princess Sarah (Kibby) L/W another typical Junior who also should improve as she matures, at present she is not balanced. She is good for her size and not exaggerated. A bit happy of her tail on the move. YB (4) 1 Teignvalley Rags to Riches JW (Hill) B/W I adore the shape of this girl, she is deep through the body with excellent rear angles. She sports a superb head with the darkest of eyes. Sound and steady on the move. 2 Carlyquinn Winter Storm JW (Cokell) L/W another top quality exhibit who is so well made. Another glorious head, so correct. I found these two difficult to split. I think once this girl has had a litter she will finish in body and be a hard one to beat. Moved well. 3 Sieger's See Eye to Eye with Trimere (Imp Dk) NAF (Corbett) PGB (12,2) 1 Melverly Amy Dorrit with Coastalglows (Harris) B/W and just up my street. Deep in body, well coupled with excellent rear angulation. Still immature in body and needs to spring in the rib. She moved steadily both ways. One for the future. 2 Hunterheck Carianna (Ternent) L/W in profile she presents a balanced picture. What I would describe as a good honest bitch, not extreme in any way. Pleasant head with gentle expression. She was sound but distracted on the move. 3 Plaiglen One Last Time (Glendinning) LB (7,1) 1 Annavah Aquarius (Havard) L/W who caught my eye as soon as I looked at this class. She is not overdone in any way. So balanced to go over and construction on point. Looking at her breeding I see she is an amalgamation of two top kennels both have put their quality into the creation of such an exciting prospect. Her movement just cemented her top honours as she just drove out and floated to take the class and later the RCC. 2 Petranella Tipping The Wink JW (Savell) L/W typical and quality girl from a kennel that has consistently produced. Excellent front assembly, depth in body and superb rear angulation. Well-balanced head feminine head. She moved sound and true. Carrying a bit too much weight for me today. 3 Daenerys Moondancer to Cherishym (Richardson & Terry-Richardson) OB (7,2) 1 Elazlan Coronation Day JW (Chandler) L/W Sheer quality and elegance. She sports the most exquisite refined head piece. Not overdone in any manner and balanced throughout. She moved so soundly. CC and BOB. 2 Sh Ch Trimere Time Flys (Corbett) L/W another top-notch exhibit who exuded quality. So exceptionally well put together. She has a fabulous head. I found her a pleasure to go over. Nitpicking with these two as this girl was exceptional on the move. I chose my winner in the end over her on shortness in back, such a small thing, but they were hard to

separate. 3 Sh Ch Melverly Iridescent (Smith) VB (1) 1 Ir Sh Ch Clentonian Pandemonium JW ShCEx OSW VW (Mrs M Hydon) B/W this bitch has just gone from strength to strength, full of quality and type, not excessive in any way but moderate throughout. Her movement is excellent and I put in my notes that she could teach a lot of the youngsters how to drive out. Delighted she was placed in the veteran group a great ambassador for the breed. BV Special Beginners B (6) 1 Forgespring Nobody's Fool at Blissenbea (Proctor) See Junior bitch. 2 Calvdale Padlurowncanoe at Zawspring (Wilson) B/W lovely head and expression. Excellent front and rear assembly, could be a little shorter in the back. She is a joy to assess on the move, true in front and excellent rear drive. 3 Hunterheck Lost in A Spell (Le-Clerc) Good Citizen Dog Scheme B (4) 1 Trimere Taylor Maid at Pinhays JW ShCEx OSW (Mrs J I Kibby) L/W a quality bitch presented immaculately. She presents such a balanced shape on the stack and is good to handle. Elegant neck with crest nice angles for and rear. She moved soundly, not as positive in rear action. 2 Cobhay Fancy Phlox (Williams & Toublic) L/W a very nice girl and type I like. Beautiful head, neck leading into well-angled shoulders, so well conditioned in the thigh. She could be a touch shorter in the back. She moved with drive covering the ground with ease. 3 Barecho Cover Girl of Svenjak (Imp Swe) (Gardiner)
