Well made confident youngster, head is balanced with lovely eye colour, good shoulders and depth of body, hindquarters are well rounded, moved well once settled

Baby Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Elazlan Elle for Leather (Mr & Mrs M Calvert)

Litter sister to above and many of the same qualities, lovely outline, nice neck into shoulders, well made quarters, pleasing head with such a sweet expression she had to be B.B.P.

2nd Place - Peasblossom Emotions with Teignvalley (Mrs C Hill)

Another quality puppy, attractive head, eyes of a good eye colour, straight in front, lovely bone, nice depth for her age, well constructed rear, moved okay.

Minor Puppy Dog

1st Place - Peasblossom Daredevil for Tiverstone (Mrs J V Shovel)

Well shaped head with correct stop and good eye colour, he has a lovely frame and is nicely boned, good in front, right amount of depth, shown in lovely condition, once settled he moved well, a happy pup enjoying his day.

Puppy Dog

1st Place - Daenerys Catching Fire at Dexbenella (Mr S P & Mrs W M Walker)

Well proportioned puppy with good bone, feet could be tighter. Head is balanced, good neck and depth of chest, well coupled, hindquarters have width, moderate bend of stifle, moved accurately with a good stride.

2nd Place - Forgespring Tomfoolery (Mrs C E & Mr P J Turrell)

Liked his overall style and balance His head is in proportion, with correctly shaped dark eyes, he stands true in front with good bone and feet. Moderate angles front and back, just needs time to fill out.

Junior Dog

1st Place – Beresford Stand N' Stare (Mrs T E Topliss)

Masculine head with pleasing eye colour and expression. Good neck into shoulders,

well bodied for his age, straight forelegs with elbows tight to his body, lovely bone and neat feet, firm topline. Lively youngster well handled to show his forward reach and drive. Shown in top condition. B.P.I.S.

2nd Place – Gleadbury Whataboy at Mujascal (Miss J A Such)

Well made boy with depth and substance, pleasant head, eyes still darkening but they have a kind expression, good neck into decent shoulders, moderately angled hindquarters with good muscle tone, moved well.

Yearling Dog

1st Place - Teignvalley New Beginnings JW (Mrs C Hill)

Attractive outline on this youngster, refined in head with soft expression in his dark eyes. Liked his neck into shoulders and well proportioned body, straight front, neat feet, moderate angulations, moved soundly keeping a firm topline.

Novice Dog

1st Place – Beresford Stand N'Stare (Mrs T E Topliss)

2nd Place – Gleadbury Mad About the Boy (Mrs C A House)

Presents a lovely outline, pleasing head, eyes have a gentle expression, nice reach of neck, good in front, enough depth, just needs more time to finish. Moved with an easy stride.

Post Graduate Dog

1st Place - Meadowdale Twix (Mr S & Mrs J Eyeington)

Strongly built boy with good bone and substance. Masculine in head, little steep in stop, correctly shaped dark eyes, good fill to chest, well ribbed, balanced in angulations front and back, muscular hindquarters, in good coat, strong accurate movement and shown in hard condition.

2nd Place - Peasblossom Brogan at Gaolachcara (Ms Stevenson) Balanced in outline, head has lovely chiselling, eyes have a nice expression, deep in chest, well coupled, good width to thighs, hocks well let down, moves with drive, just needs time to mature a little more.

1st Place - Sh Ch/slo/cro Ch Peasblossom Xanti (Mr & Mrs D Mitchell)

B/W of good size, refined chiselled head with dark eyes, elbow set tight to a deep chest, strong neck into well placed shoulders, firm in topline, well ribbed, hindquarters are muscled, moderate in stifle, hocks well let down, tight feet .Sound accurate movement. C.C. B.O.B.

2nd Place - Sh Ch Beresford Bolt from The Blue (Mrs T E Topliss)

Classy B/W of substance, head has lovely chiselling and fluting, dark eyes, shoulders are well laid, super bone, firm topline, broad strong quarters sent him around the ring covering the ground well. In excellent coat and condition.

1st Place - Sh Ch Meadowdale Daisydale Lightning Bolt (Mr S & Mrs J Eyeington)

B/W/T shown in sparkling coat and condition, masculine head with correctly shaped dark eyes, arched neck, good depth of chest, matching angles front and rear, good bone and tight feet, moved holding his top line and with reach in front and drive behind, lovely head and tail carriage. R.C.C.

1st Place - Sh Ch Beresford Lockdown (Mrs T E Topliss)

Stylish L/W with overall balance, pleasing head, eyes are the correct shape and colour,

good shoulders, well filled frame, neat feet, muscled hindquarters, in lovely coat and condition moved soundly keeping his topline.

Minor Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Peasblossom Dreams (Mr & Mrs D Mitchell)

Lovely youngster, so together for her age, sweet feminine head with an appealing expression, good depth, well coupled, good bone and feet, well muscled, free sound movement.

2nd Place -Spuffing Daiquiri at Gaolachcara (Ms Stevenson)

Mature puppy, her head is well proportioned; eyes are a good colour with a kind expression, good neck into shoulders, balanced angles front and rear. Moved well with some drive.

Puppy Bitch

1st Place - Chanangel Yorkshire Honey (Mr & Mrs M Calvert)

Attractive outline, pleasing head and eye, straight in front with tight elbows, firm topline, good depth, well shaped hindquarters with good muscle tone, sound in movement with good forward reach.

2nd - Eastriding Royal Style (Mrs K Jenkinson)

Liked her overall style, head shows work and she has a sweet expression, balanced in body with good shoulders, hindquarters have width, enough depth, moved with lovely head and tail carriage.

Junior Bitch

1st Place - Daenerys Winter Solstice at Fecimus (Mr J & Miss A Harrison & MacBain)

Elegant in outline and of a good size, balanced head with good work, correctly shaped dark eyes, lovely neck, well angled front assembly, good depth of body, correctly angled hindquarters, neat hocks and tight feet, sound and precise in movement .

2nd Place - Beresford Stand On Ceremony (Mrs T E Topliss)

L/W girl with substance, feminine head, a little more to come in muzzle, eyes have a lovely expression, arched neck into a well constructed forehand, elbows tight to her body, good bone and feet, moved well once she got into her stride

Yearling Bitch

1st Place - Plaiglen One Last Time (Ms F Glendinning)

Balanced in outline and of good type, pretty worked head, eyes are the correct shape and colour, straight in front with depth to her chest, well laid shoulders, good width to her moderately angled quarters, tight feet, moved keeping a firm topline.

2nd Place Carlyquinn Winter Storm JW (Mrs H Cokell)

Quality bitch of a different style to 1. Feminine head with a soft expression in her eyes, good length of neck, deep through body, good bone and feet, hindquarters have good width, neat hocks, shown in lovely coat and feather.

Novice Bitch

1st Place - Peasblossom Celeste (Mr D J & Mrs E B Whitley)

Well coupled B/W, balanced in head with a lovely dark eye, good bone, straight front, nice depth of body, well muscled hindquarters, moved soundly.

2nd Place - Meonstoke Wild Cherry at Harvancourt (Miss T & Mrs J Turvey & Murray)

Liked the style of this bitch, pleasant head and eye, good neck, stands correct in front, moderate angles front and back, enough depth, firm topline, moved with a good stride once settled.

Post Graduate Bitch

1st Place - Dexbenella in My Dreams with Moontorn JW (Miss A Bellamy)

Attractive outline, well proportioned head and sweet expression, decent shoulders, compact in body with good substance, well ribbed, strong through loin, moderate hind angulation, neat hocks and tight feet, moved with good drive.

2nd Place - Melverly Amy Dorrit with Coastalgloves (Mrs J L Harris)

B/W shown with gleaming coat and in top condition. Beautiful worked head, dark eyes with a melting expression, good reach of neck into well laid shoulders, good ribs and depth of body, neat feet, hindquarters well let down, moved with accuracy.

Limit Bitch

1st Place - Elazlan Coronation Day JW (Miss E Chandler)

Stylish L/W with an elegant outline, sweet feminine head, good length of neck, well placed shoulders, straight in front, good bone and feet well, coupled, hindquarters have width and are well muscled, moved with good reach in front and with drive.

2nd Place - Melverly Betsy Trotwood with Coastalgloves (Mrs J L Harris)

Pleasing in head with good eye colour and expression, strong neck, shoulders are well angled, good depth to chest, short coupled, nice depth of body, moderate rear angulation Moved steadily with precision.

1st Place - Meltarose Madeleine at Meonstoke (Mrs K C Taubman)

L/W of substance, attractive in outline with a well proportioned body, super head with fluting and chiselling, eyes have a kind look, arched neck into well laid shoulders, muscled rear quarters, moved with good extension in front and drive behind.

Champion in Memory of Jimmy Cudworth - Bitch

1st Place - Sh Ch Calvdale Flutter JW (Mr & Mrs M Calvert)

Loved the flow from her head into her neck. Feminine head showing work, eyes are the correct colour and with a gentle expression, good front assembly, right amount of depth, well coupled, good bone and feet, moderate bend of stifle and hocks, hindquarters have width, presented in top condition. Easy long striding movement with drive. C.C., R.B.O.B

2nd Place - Sh Ch Trimere Time Flys (Mrs A Corbett)

Balanced feminine head, dark eyes with sweetest of expressions, strong neck, shoulders are well placed, elbows tight, neat feet, good depth, well ribbed, hindquarters are muscled, sound in movement. In lovely coat and feather.

Veteran Bitch

1st Place - Potrail Turns The Swag On for Pinereoch (Ms L & Mrs A H Wilson & Connor)

Loved her type, beautiful worked head, dark eyes with a mischievous expression, good neck, correct forehand and rear angulations, compact in body with good substance, strong through loin, well made quarters, tight feet, moved covering the ground well, keeping a firm topline and with an ever wagging tail. 1st Place - Trimere Taylor Maid at Pinhays JW ShCEx OSW (Mrs J I Kibby)

Shapely in outline, pretty feminine head, eyes are the correct shape with a gentle look, good neck into well placed shoulders, enough depth, moderately angled quarters, moved soundly with a good stride. 2nd Place - Seaspring Windcatcher at Chipewyan (Mrs P Strover)

Well balanced head with lovely eye colour; good neck into decent shoulders, ribs well

sprung, deep through body super bone and feet, shade long cast, moderate rear angles, moved well with good tail carriage.
