Spaniel-English Springer

MPD (2, 1) I Darling's Elazlan Night Hawk Very pleasing head of correct proportions on this promising youngster, tight kind eye, good pigment, strong neck into well laid shoulders, well boned, strong topline leading to nicely angled rear with nothing overdone which he used to advantage as he moved steadily with drive

PD (3) I Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Gold Very balanced with excellent angles both front and rear, very pleasing head with good eye, clean neck leading to lovely shoulder construction with correct return of upperarm, strong topline and well angled quarters from which he moved so well with good drive along with lovely foreleg movement. 2 Shoval's Peasblossom Daredevil For TiverstonE Pleasing head with dark eye, straight front and tight feet, not quite as balanced overall as 1 at this point but reasonable quarters and moved OK. 3 Tolladay's Chanangel Yorkshire Ale With Bethersden

JD (3) I Such's Gleadbury Whataboy At Mujascal True Springer head with super expression from tight eyes, good bone and compact feet, deepening in chest, well constructed shoulders which corresponded with rear angles, firm topline, short coupled, moved very well both front and rear. 2 Topliss's Beresford Stand At Ease Another with typical head giving pleasing expression, well set ears, reasonable shoulders, strong topline and correct quarters but carrying a tad too much weight which adversely affected his movement today, 3 Topliss's Beresford Stand N' Stare

PGD (3,1) I Hill's Teignvalley New Beginnings JW Stood out both standing and on the move, well proportioned head, tight dark expressive eye, excellent shoulder construction, well ribbed, strong topline, good quarters, so balanced throughout and moved out so well. 2 Stevenson's Peasblossom Brogan At Gaolachcara Ok head with well set ears, reasonable layback of shoulder but would like better return of upperarm, deep chest and OK quarters, not in the best of coats but moved quite well.

LD (2) I Tracz's Beresford On My Way With Acregate Very pleasing and typical head and eye along with well set ears and good pigment, strong bone on straight forelegs with tight well shaped feet, well laid shoulders, deep chest, well ribbed strong loin, muscular quarters with just the right bend of stifle, well proportioned and balanced overall and did not disappoint on the move with good front action and powerful drive from the rear. Well deserved RCC

2 Warrener's Eastfalla Sherlockholmes. Reasonable head with good dark eye, straight front and tight feet, OK shoulders, correct body proportions and reasonable quarters, moved well in front but a bit close behind today.

OD (6) I Darling's Elazlan Billy Kimber This dog is so very balanced with everything in proportion, loved everything about him, super head of correct proportions, masculine but with such a gentle endearing expression, clean strong neck, deep chest, good length of neck leading to well laid back shoulders with correct return of upperarm, well ribbed, strong topline with muscular loin, broad thigh and well developed quarters with just the right amount of bend of stifle, moved so well covering the ground with such ease with super front action and good drive from rear holding topline and clearly enjoying his day. CC & BOB 2 Terry-Richardson & Richardson's Cherishym Dofida Close up and another lovely boy but not giving of his best today, another with a super head and expression, good neck into very well laid shoulders, strong topline, deep chest, well ribbed, correct angles both front and rear, seemed to settle a good bit more once he moved and this he did with good front action and drive from the rear 3 Wilson & Connor's Sh Ch Pinereoch No Stunts Larrie

MPB (2) I Calvert's Elazlan Elle For Leather What a beautifully balanced youngster loved her head and expression really well constructed front assembly with good bone and clean neck, strong topline, short in coupling and nicely angled hindquarters, moved so well, straight front and rear with drive and animation. Must have a bright future. 2 Hill's Peasblossom Emotions With Teignvalley Very close up and another very promising puppy, so well constructed throughout with lovely head and expressive eye, at this stage not quite as balanced in outline as I but beautiful angles both fore and aft with strong topline and short loin, moved out with front reach and drive from strong quarters.

PB (5) 1 Calvert's Chanangel Yorkshire Honey loved her as she presented such a super profile, so balanced overall even at this age, super Springer head, good eye and expression, well off for bone, text book shoulder construction with corresponding hindquarters, firm topline, strong loin, well coupled and used her quarters to advantage as she moved so well with drive and animation. BP 2 Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Style Similar comments to above with similar construction, eye still needs to darken but that will come I'm sure, moved really well though not as positive in front as 1 at this stage. 3 Havard's Annavah Ablaze

JB (4, 1) Very difficult to split 1 and 2 but just felt 1 was a tad more balanced at this point but splitting hairs. 1 Taubman's Meonstoke Wild Thyme Lovely head, straight front, good bone, tight feet enough depth of chest for age, clean neck into well laid shoulders, strong topline and correct angulation on quarters with nothing exaggerated, moved really well both front and rear. 2 McBain & Harrison's Daenerys Solstice At Fecimus Above comments apply and she also moved extremely well but not quite so balanced as 1 on the move today but these 2 will no doubt change places often as both very nice examples of the breed. 3 Pattison's Forgespring Foolproof

PGB (9, 2) 1 Joyce's Peasblossom Aura At Felltops Nothing overdone with this girl, well balanced feminine head with soft expression, strong neck into well laid shoulders, strong topline and angles not overdone on quarters which meant she moved with strong drive whilst maintaining true Springer front action. 2 Osbourne's Tiroen Typically Braego (KCJ) Well proportioned head with well set ears, shoulders well laid, good bone enough depth of chest, firm topline and good quarters, moved well. 3 Topliss's Shersona I Believe In Angels At Beresford

LB (6) 1 Havard's Annavah Aquarius Typical feminine head, so balanced and presented a kind expression from well shaped dark eye, stood straight in front with tight feet, good length of neck into laid back shoulder strong quarters with moderate angles, deep chest, well ribbed strong loin, moved very well with correct front action along with driving rear, true both front and rear, strong challenge for top honours .. 2. Frusher & Slack's Chanangel When You Believe At Shersona Another good mover with nothing overdone and presented a balanced picture in profile, very pleasing head and eye, good straight front and tight feet, well laid shoulders, deep chest and well ribbed, strong topline held on the move ,

muscular thighs and correct bend of stifle. Moved very well both front and rear. 3 Savell's Petranella Tipping The Wink JW

OB (2, 1) I Calvert's Sh Ch Calvdale Flutter JW Beautifully balanced throughout with nothing overdone from well shaped feminine head and melting expression from tight kind eye, straight well boned front through muscular neck and well laid shoulders with good return of upperarm to strong topline and rear assembly with the strength and angles I like to see in this breed, she is so well proportioned and sound throughout and her movement is true Springer where forelegs swing forward while hocks enable driving action from the rear and she puts this together with style as she covers the ground with ease and animation. Well deserved CC& BOS

VB (2) Two worthy 8 year old Champions who are a credit to their owners. I Hydon's Ir Sh Ch Clentonian Pandemonium JW SHCEX OSW VW Lovely balanced true Springer head, expressive dark dark eye, good forehand, well laid shoulders, deep chest, well sprung ribs, short coupled correct quarters and moved in true breed style presenting a very balanced outline. Pressed hard for top honours. BV 2 Wilson & Connor's Sh Ch Potrail Turns The Swag On For Pinereoch Above comments apply as another lovely example of the breed who also moved very well but just preferred the overall balance of I on the move where she moved with reach and drive.
