Thank you to the Committee for the invitation to award my first set of CCs. I thoroughly enjoyed my day & the weather held up at this lovely venue. First class catering & it was lovely to see old friends. My thanks to my steward Mr A Niven for his efficiency & keeping the ring running smoothly

MPD (1) 1 Darling's Elazlan Night Hawk, 8 month old B/W, lovely balanced head with soft expression, correct length of neck into well laid shoulders. Good bone, stands on tight feet. In excellent coat, still very much a baby on the move. Has a good future. PD (2) 1 Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Gold – 11 month old L/W, balanced in head & good length of neck, correct angles fore & aft, good bone throughout, moves with reach & drive. I'm sure his future is bright. Best Puppy Dog, 2 Tolladay's Chanangel Yorkshire Ale With Bethersden, 11 month old L/W same attributes as the winner, very close decision on the day. Another one with a good future ahead of him JD (1) 1 House's Gleadbury Mad About The Boy, I would prefer a bit more size to him & a more masculine head but he still has time to fill out. Good ribs, correct legs & feet. He moved out really well. YD (2) 1 G Mad About The Boy 2 Hill's Teignvalley New Beginnings JW, B/W who is nicely put together but not as balanced as the winner. Pleasing on the move but wasn't settled on the stack. PGD (2) 1 Stevenson's Peasblossom Brogan At Gaolachcara, L/W with a lovely head & soft expression. Correct length of neck, good spring of rib & boning, stands on good feet, good angles fore & aft, moved with drive round the ring. 2 Le-Clerc's Hunterheck Fade To Black, nice breed type with similar attributes as the 1st but didn't go as well on the move LD (4) 1 Tracz's Beresford On My Way With Acregate, outstanding L/W, lovely head & eye giving that soft expression. Correct bone, in excellent coat & condition. Moved well here but not as settled in the challenge, pushed hard for the Res CC 2 Mitchell's Peasblossom Changes, lovely L/W with a good head, slightly different to the winner. Good length of neck & ribs. Strong in bone, correct feet, moved well OD (4) 1 Terry-Richardson & Richardson's Cherishym Dofida, here is a genuine all round good Springer & one I have always liked since he first came out. Today he was presented in pristine condition. Lovely masculine head, good boning throughout. Nothing is overdone & he was lovely to go over. He moved out with reach & drive, at one with his handler. – Dog CC which I'm delighted to say gave him his title 2 Darling's Elazlan Billy Kimber, another lovely B/W, bigger than the winner, He is younger than the 1st & not yet the finished product for me. Correct bone & angles. Close up to the CC winner, had to settle for the Res CC today, but I'm sure his time will come very soon Special Beginners Dog (1) 1.H Fade To Black

MPB (2) 1 Calvert's Elazlan Elle For Leather, absolutely stunning, L/W who stole my heart. Excels in breed type, already has so much ring presence, The future looks very promising for this young lady who will wear her crown before long – Res Bitch CC, Best Puppy Bitch, Best Puppy in Show 2 Hill's Peasblossom Emotions With Teignvalley, B/W another very nice puppy, feminine throughout, no mistaking her sex, not as settled on the move as 1st very promising. PB (6) 1 Jenkinson's Eastriding Royal Style, litter sister to my Best Puppy Dog, feminine head, good length of neck leading into correct shoulders & ribs. She stands on tight feet, moved out well 2 Mitchell's Peasblossom Dreams, B/W similar attributes to 1st but sadly not as settled on the move. A lovely bitch all through YB (1) 1 Hill's Teignvalley Rags To Riches JW, this B/W stood alone today, put together well with good planes, good bone & round tight feet, moved out well PGB (6) 1 Tolladay's Calvdale Half A Story At Bethersden, quality B/W who excels in neck, lovely substance & bone, correct spring of rib, drove out well round the ring, pushed hard for the Res CC 2 Joyce's Peasblossom Aura At Felltops,

L/W who was finer all through than the winner but still a nice bitch. Another good mover LB (6) 1 Harris' Melverly Amy Dorrit With Coastalglows. B/W litter sister to Betsy Trotwood but I do prefer this girl. Lovely head with sweet expression, correct length of neck, her front is in balance with her rear, moved well 2 Hill's Peasblossom Tupelo Honey With Teignvalley, B/W/T different type to the winner, lots to like about her, correct angles fore & aft. Moved well OB (3) 1 Smith's Sh Ch Melverly Iridescent, outstanding L/W lovely top quality girl who Ive loved since I first set eyes on her. Excels in breed type with correct bone & spring of rib. There is nothing that I would change about her. Stole the show, my Bitch CC & BIS winner 2 Chandler's Sh Ch Elazlan Coronation Day JW, another quality bitch who gave the winner a run for her money. Oozes breed type from her feminine head to her lovely tight feet. Moved with drive. Champion B (2) 1 Smith's Sh Ch Melverly Vignette, another quality bitch from this kennel, Feminine head, correct neck, good angles. Lovely bone throughout, Just not wearing her full coat today, A very worthy champion. Special Beginners B (1) 1 Le-Clerc's Hunterheck Lost In A Spell, 4th in Post Graduate Bitch. VB (2) 1 Wilson & Connor's Sh Ch Potrail Turns The Swag On For Pinereoch, 8 year old L/W of quality breed type, good angles front & rear. Moved well round the ring. Best Veteran in Show
