1st: LE-CLERC, Mrs Amy & LE-CLERC, Mr Michael Hunterheck Fade To Black. Nice type, of satisfactory make and shape. Good backline which he holds well, good in rib, reasonable mover, just needs to be a little more accurate in front and be careful with his foot placement. Good head proportions with kind and typical expression.

Pleasing class of typical exhibits

1st: JENKINSON, Mrs K Eastriding Royal Gold. Handsome, well constructed youngster who appealed in most areas. Presented in beautiful condition with coat of excellent texture. Super head properties with correct skull and foreface and likeable expression. Shapely neck and well made shoulder, good bone, correct angulation to the rear, nice free mover

2nd: TOPLISS, Mrs T E Beresford Stand At Ease. Another attractive juvenile. Not quite as accurate on the move as winner. Well bodied with good rib, loin and width of thigh. Head developing nicely and expression pleasing.

PGD (2 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: STEVENSON, Ms E Peasblossom Brogan At Gaolachcara. Really scored in profile movement, exemplary reach and drive with ground covering efficiency. Good head of desired shape and balance with soft expression. Reasonable angulation fore and aft, well bodied and firm, typical in outline 2nd: LE-CLERC, Mrs Amy & LE-CLERC, Mr Michael Hunterheck Fade To Black

LD (3 Entries) Abs: 1

Liked both dogs here presented in top notch condition

1st: MITCHELL, Mr & Mrs D & J Peasblossom Changes. Masculine dog of great quality, beautifully proportioned and stands balanced on lovely legs and feet. Very attractive head with pleasing skull and foreface, well placed and shaped eye, kindly expression. Lovely body lines with good rib and loin, well muscled without bulk, good bone. Sound, true mover who carries himself well. Not discounted in the challenge.

2nd: TRACZ, Miss Jennie J Beresford On My Way With Acregate. So much to like. Well made throughout and very good to go over, good forehand assembly leading into well ribbed body, loin and quarters. I fractionally preferred the firmness and positivity of the winner on the move but I am sure this charming exhibit will always claim high status

Class 1104 OD (6 Entries) Abs: 0.

Super class of typical individuals built on pleasing lines.

1st: DARLING, Mrs Carol Elazlan Billy Kimber. Very attractive male who fills the eye. I liked his scope and typical balanced outline with nothing overdone, every part just

flows into the neck as it should. Correct length of neck, well set on, with well laid shoulder and good upper arm. Stands on good well padded feet well placed under his strong but athletic body, good in rib and loin, hence pleasing underline, all leading to shapely rear assembly. Moves easily with correct length of stride as one would expect from his construction. I liked his head and expression very much. He answered all the questions. CC

2nd: MITCHELL, Mr & Mrs D & J Sh Ch Peasblossom Xanti. I have had the great good fortune to watch this dog reach full maturity and a very glamorous and lovely example of the breed he is. Nothing I have said before is revoked. It was a very close decision with no more than a cigarette paper between 1 and 2. RCC

SBB (1 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: LE-CLERC, Mrs Amy & LE-CLERC, Mr Michael Hunterheck Lost In A Spell. Feminine and all in proportion, a good workmanlike sort with lots to like. Sweet expression, skull and muzzle balanced but could have a little more length for me. Moved fine when settled. In good coat.

VB (1 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: WILSON, Ms L & CONNOR, Mrs A Sh Ch Potrail Turns The Swag On For Pinereoch. Lovely type and in fine form. I was very impressed with exhibits produced by this kennel. Presents an excellent picture in profile with everything where it should be and did not disappoint on closer inspection. Lovely eye, kind, well shaped and set beautifully to give the highly desired expression, good headpiece generally. Correct bone, legs and feet. Good in forehand, well bodied, good back line. Nice angulation all through. Moves freely and truly fore and aft. Close up in the challenge.

MPB (1 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: CALVERT, Mr M & CALVERT, Mrs N Elazlan Elle For Leather. Very much a baby and I would not want her any other way. Clearly has all the potential to finish well. Pretty and pleasing in head, a tad light in eye but it did not unduly detract from her expression. Well presented in beautiful nick. Good bone and feet. Clean lines throughout. Good length of neck, nice shoulders, well ribbed and good loin. Correctly let down behind and indeed good normal angulation all through. Moved nicely for her age with considerable control.

PB (1 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: MITCHELL, Mr & Mrs D & J Peasblossom Dreams Lively B/W/T who appealed, built on classic lines, presents well in profile and covered the ground with ease and typical gait when settled. Such a well proportioned and lovely head and sweet expression. Satisfactory neck and shoulders with correct upper arm, good depth of chest and spring of ribs, nice shapely rear quarters. Good quality of bone. I liked her a lot. BP

JB (6 Entries) Abs: 2

1st: NICKLIN, Mr Lewis Daenerys Girl On Fire At Dexbenella. Clear winner on front placement both standing and on the move. Classy individual, stands balanced on lovely legs and feet and nicely made throughout. Feminine, well proportioned head with good skull and foreface. Good in rib, body and loin. Nicely constructed behind which she used to advantage to move very effectively.

2nd: STEVENSON, Ms E Spuffing Daiquiri At Gaolachcara. Lovely honest bitch of sensible make and shape and proportions generally. Liked her head which she carried well on neck of sensible length which flowed smoothly into the line of the back. Found her very pleasing to go over

3rd: PROCTOR, Mrs Maddie Forgespring Nobody's Fool. Black-and-white a bit lethargic which was a shame as I liked her.

PGB (4 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: WHITLEY, Mrs E B & WHITLEY, Mr D J Peasblossom Celeste. Headed two lovely feminine exhibits. Eyecatching and well balanced 1 has a lovely head with gentle expression, well set on a neck of correct length and strength which seamlessly leads to well laid shoulders. Body lines please and quarters are shapely, all is as it should be and as a result she moves soundly

2nd: JOYCE, Mrs Susan & JOYCE, Mr Neal Peasblossom Aura At Felltops. Another one I liked for type, honest, well proportioned and active in appearance. Foot placement could be better in front, but otherwise scores in neck and shoulder and firm topline. Good efficient mover.

LB (8 Entries) Abs: 1

Smashing class, thank goodness there are bitches of this calibre, I hope they have their opportunity in the maternity stakes

1st: HARRIS, Mrs Jayne L Melverly Amy Dorrit With Coastalglows has it all in an unexaggerated way, super type, good height to length ratios, quality bone, good head pattern with gentle expression, lovely legs and feet, good neck and shoulder, well developed in chest and body with strength where required but with no lack of femininity, loved her rear assembly with good width across her rump and short strong pasterns used to effect for effortless movement

2nd: CORBETT, Mrs Ann Sieger's See Eye To Eye With Trimere (Imp Dnk) A.ex NAF maturing nicely and fits the standard well, built on classic lines and in tip top condition. Correct straight front, good reach of neck, shoulder and upper arm angulation, well bodied, firm in loin, moved out well as expected with pleasing quarters providing power behind. Just fractionally preferred headpiece of 1 but enjoyed going over both of these smashing exhibits

OB (4 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: CORBETT, Mrs Ann Sh Ch Trimere Time Fly's. I loved this bitch last time I judged her and she is now fully mature and still presented in top form and well fettled. All my previous remarks apply. She is an exemplary specimen who radiates classic breed type and carries herself with a magnetism that is very hard to deny. There was plenty of competition in this class and elsewhere today so it was not a given that she would be best of her sex. However with her beautiful head and wonderful frame she demonstrated how well put together she is covering the ground truly and efficiently and with style but absolutely free from exaggeration. 2nd: CHANDLER, Miss Elizabeth Sh Ch Elazlan Coronation Day J.W. Not surprised to find this lovely exhibit was in the upper house. Beautifully presented in super condition and sympathetically handled there was so much going for this one, good in outline, of correct size, stands balanced on good legs and well padded feet, I liked her skull and foreface, feminine throughout, good neckline and forehead generally, she is well bodied and ribbed back nicely, with good underline and pleasing angulation fore and aft.
