Minor Puppy Dog 0

Puppy Dog 1

1ST Peasblossom Eros (Miss P Watts) A lovely balanced boy. Good depth of chest. Moved steady and held topline on the move. Head still to break. Dark eye balanced length of foreface to skull. BPD and BP

Junior Dog 1

1ST Beresford Stand N' Stare JW (Mrs T E Topliss) Lovely masculine young lad. Eye is dark enough balanced head. Muzzle and skull of equal length good depth to foreface. A good length of neck to show off his well laid back shoulders. Level topline and strong loin. Still developing but shows well sprung ribs and good depth of chest. Moved well although a little excited. A well developed rear to give drive.

Yearling Dog 2 (1)

1ST Meonstoke Woodpecker at Grosbreuil (Mrs D West) Lovely boy still maturing. Good depth to chest and well sprung ribs. Beautiful head with a kind expression. Well muscled and strong loin which helped to show off his lovely movement.

Post Graduate Dog 1

1ST Clentonian Pitch Perfect (Mr R & Mrs J Reynolds) A very handsome dog. Good width to skull without being course. Totally unexaggerated throughout. Excellent front assembly good depth of chest strong topline. Well muscled. Maybe could move with more purpose.

Limit Dog 2

1ST Gleadbury It Is Destiny for Anacapa (Mrs H Merry) Dark eye and a lovely kind expression. Compact in style. Good depth and width to chest. Sufficient bone for a male. Strong loin, wide muscular thighs and short rear pasterns.

2ND Peasblossom Brogan at Gaolachcara (Ms Stevenson) stronger in head than 1 but still has that soft springer expression. He is still a little tucked up and I would prefer less slope to the croup. Has a lovely length of neck which goes into well laid back shoulders. In super condition and well presented.

Open Dog 5 (1)

1ST Greg De Les Tres Llacunes (Imp Esp) (Mr C & Mrs J Gledhill) Loved his head and expression, good width to the skull without being heavy moderate stop and fluting which some are missing. Moderately angled front and rear moved steady with reach and drive. Well presented. Considered for top honours just didn't come across as finished as my CC and Res CC winners
2ND Beresford On My Way with Acregate (Miss J J Tracz) Liked this boys head balanced foreface to skull. Had a good length of neck and well laid back shoulders not the return of upper arm as 1. A beautiful strong short loin and well muscled strong rear end. Moved ok just gave his handler a tough time.

3RD Sh Ch Sandylands Xpress Delivery (Mr E & Mrs E Casey & Jayes)

1ST Sh Ch Sandylands Stand N Deliver (Mrs T E Topliss) What a star really owned the ring. He is masculine all through. A kind dark eye balance head. A good length of neck with a slight arch into a lovely layback of shoulder. Moderately angled and a strong loin. When moving steady he held his topline and showed off his lovely reach and drive. DCC

2ND Sh Ch Beresford Lockdown (Mrs T E Topliss) Another lovely dog Beautiful almond shaped dark eye to give that soft expression Balanced all through and moved well around the ring narrowly missing out to his kennel mate who just had a bit more pizzazz today. RDCC

Special Beginners 3 (1) This was a class of two halves the older more mature bitch verses the young still lots to give junior

1ST Clentonian Picture Perfect (Mr R & Mrs J Reynolds) Although now a veteran she is still in good fettle. Very pretty, good depth and width to chest and an excellent front angulation. Moved steady around the ring showing plenty of rear drive. BSB

2ND Forgespring Fool Me Once (Mrs El Stephens) Very much a youngster but held her own. Lovely dark eye. Balanced throughout. Moved lovely around the ring.

1ST Annava Ablaze (Miss L A & Mrs P J Havard) Pretty bitch good length of neck which flowed into a good lay back of shoulder. Good depth of chest and well sprung ribs. Lovely balanced moderate angulations. Moved well around the ring.

2ND Beresford Stand On Ceremony (Mrs T E Topliss) Very feminine, dark eye, soft expression. Good depth of chest and spring of rib. Such a shame she didn't like the floor.

3RD Forgespring Fool Me Once (Mrs El Stephens)

Yearling Bitch 4

1ST Meonstoke Wild Thyme (Mrs K C Taubman) Such a pretty bitch and so well presented. Lovely dark almond shaped eye Straight front and well angled with good length of upper arm. Beautifully presented good muscle tone and strong loin this showed in her great movement.

2ND Sieger's See Eye to Eye with Trimere (Imp Dk) NAF (Mrs A Corbett) I really liked this bitch as well. A bit stronger in head than 1 with a deeper flew. Well balanced, strong rear quarters and well muscled second thigh moved a dream.

3RD Meonstoke Wild Cherry at Harvancourt (Miss T & Mrs J Turvey & Murray)

Novice Bitch 2

1ST Forgespring Fool Me Once (Mrs El Stephens) repeat

2ND Beresford Stand Aside (Mrs T E Topliss) Very feminine balanced head with a kind eye. Strong forechest, deep and a good length of upper arm. Beautifully put together just would not settle on the move which made it difficult to assess.

Post Graduate Bitch 4(2)

1ST 1121 - Shersona I Believe in Angels at Beresford (Mrs T E Topliss) Pretty bitch with a lovely dark eye. Good length of neck into a good lay of shoulder. Moderately angled level topline which she held on the move. Moved steadily showing good reach and drive.

2ND 1096 - Loxbourne Hustle and Bustle Jr Ch (Mrs M Hydon) Different in style but still a lot to like. Not as strong as 1 in front angulation. Moved well and at one with her handler.

Limit Bitch 5(1)

1ST Carlyquinn Winter Storm JW (Mrs H Cokell) A bitch I admire and is maturing wonderfully. Balanced head lovely expression. Strong neck going into well laid back shoulders. Good front angulation and a decent return of upper arm. Short strong loin. Moved well around the ring

2ND Annawah Aquarius (Miss L A & Mrs P J Havard) Different type of head to 1. She had good width and depth to her chest. Longer in loin but still strong. Well developed second thigh which allowed her to mover effortlessly around the ring.

3RD Petranella Tipping The Wink JW (Ms C P Savell)

Open Bitch 4(1)

1ST Sh Ch Sandylands Send The Roses (Mr E & Mrs E Casey & Jayes) I just love everything about this bitch from the tip of her nose to the tip of her tail. She has the most delightful soft expression which just draws you in. Well developed chest with ribs going back to give a short strong loin and a level topline. Moderately angled. Good strong well developed rear enabling her to flow around the ring. She was on top form and was not letting anyone get pass her. BCC BOB and so pleased to see her go Reserve Best in Show.

2ND Khaleesi De Les Tres Llacunes with Alhambian (Imp Esp) (Mr M & Mrs K Keely) A young bitch who still has a lot to come I am sure. Stronger in head than 1 but not overdone and still very feminine with a soft expression. Good depth and width to chest and a lovely spring of rib. Gives her handler a bit of trouble but when she settles she moves true and free

3RD Pinhays Princess Sarah (Mrs J I Kibby)

Champion Bitch 2

1ST Sh Ch Melverly Iridescent (Mr R J Smith) Such a pretty bitch. A balanced head with dark almond eye to give that soft springer expression. A compact bitch with well sprung ribs. Short strong loin and strong level topline. Moved well when not racing. RBCC

2ND Sh Ch Trimere Time Flys (Mrs A Corbett) stronger in head with a more defined stop. Beautiful front with a flowing neck into a good lay of shoulder. Well developed rear end and strong second thigh. Move with plenty of reach and drive around the ring. So much to like about these two girls

Veteran Bitch 2(1)

1ST Grosbreuil Abricot Regal (Mrs D West) Very feminine kind expression. Well developed chest with a good spring of rib. Moderate throughout. Beautifully presented good muscle tone, covering the ground with ease you would not know she was a veteran by her movement. BV
